The Process

Obtain a FSA ID

How to apply for a FSA ID – <https://fsaid.ed.gov/npas/index.htm> (opens new window).

Keep FSA ID in a safe place.

Use FSA ID as electronic signatures on the FAFSA and other aid applications.

File the [FAFSA](#) on the Web (opens a new window) as soon after Jan. 1st as possible.

Filing online is highly recommended. It speeds the aid process.

List SUNY Delhi on your FAFSA. Our Federal school code is 002857.

IMPORTANT Information for New York State residents: Higher Education Services Corporation administers New York State grants and scholarships. Graduate students do not qualify for Tuition Assistance Program (TAP). However, the TAP application is required for the payment of scholarships such as the Senator Patricia McGee Nursing Faculty Scholarship Program. You may complete a Tuition Assistance Program (TAP) application at <https://www.tapweb.org> using school code 5024

SUNY Delhi will send you all forms, applications, or instructions needed to complete your aid, including student loans. Read and follow all directions carefully.

Respond promptly to all requests from SUNY Delhi for additional information.

Use <https://studentloans.gov/myDirectLoan/index.action> to check the status of your federal direct loans.

IMPORTANT: you must be registered for 6 or more credits each semester to be eligible for Federal loans.
